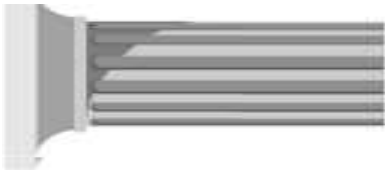
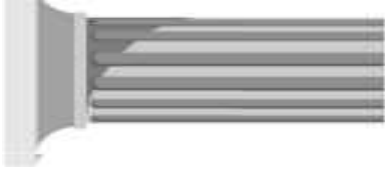

What is LatinSummer?

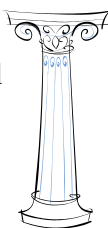

What will students learn?

LatinSummer 2011 will have a brand-new curriculum. Areas of focus will include:

- Ancient Roman culture
- Greco-Roman mythology
- Classical & Conversational Latin
- Ancient Greek language and culture

New for 2011: Latin immersion

Students in grades 6-7 will participate in a new and unique program which is challenging yet age-appropriate. Students will learn the basics of Latin through the language of the ancient Romans! The program also includes hands-on cultural activities taught in English.

5th grade students who attended *LatinSummer* in 2009 will have the option of participating in the immersion program.
