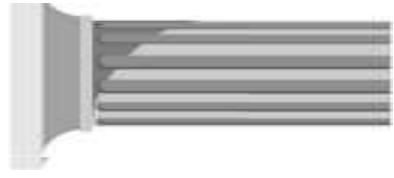

What is LatinSummer?

LatinSummer is a program that provides students a unique chance to learn about Latin and the Classical world. Over the past fourteen years, LatinSummer has introduced Latin and the Classics to students all over the country. LatinSummer returns to the Pioneer Valley to give students the opportunity to explore Latin, mythology, Roman culture, and more! The program's hands-on and exciting classes will be taught by creative, enthusiastic members of the UMass Amherst Master of Arts in Teaching Latin program under the supervision of experienced teachers. No prior knowledge of Latin or the Classics is required.

What will students learn?

Areas of focus will include:

Topics include: Latin vocab and roots, hands-on Latin sentences, Olympic games, Roman clothing, gladiators, architecture, banquets, mosaics and art, gods and goddesses, + more!

Students will be grouped by age. Instruction, pacing, and content will be tailored to the unique needs of each age group.
