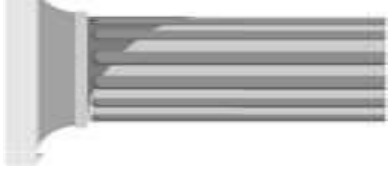

### What will students learn?

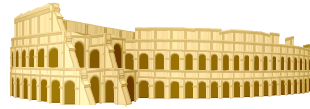
Areas of focus will include:
